CCAM Organizational Structure

The membership of the County Commissioners Association of Missouri (CCAM) totals 109 county governments.

There are actually 114 counties in the state of Missouri. Five of these are the "home rule" charter counties of Clay, St. Charles, St. Louis, Jefferson and Jackson. These counties are excluded from the statutory requirements for annual training because they do not operate under a commission form of government. The charter counties are each governed by a County Executive and County Council or Commission.

CCAM's membership totals 327 commissioners, who make up the governing bodies of its 109 member counties. There is a presiding commissioner and two associate commissioners in each of these counties.

Going back to the total of 114 Missouri county governments, 13 of them are first-class counties, with assessed valuations greater than or equal to \$1,237,928,087.

There are three second-class counties, with assessed valuations greater than \$825,285,391 but less than \$1,237,928,087.

There are 89 third-class counties, with assessed valuations of less than \$825,285,391.


There are four fourth-class counties that operate under the laws of Classification 2 because of the changes in classification laws in 1988.


