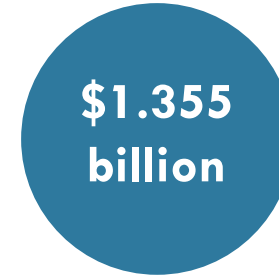

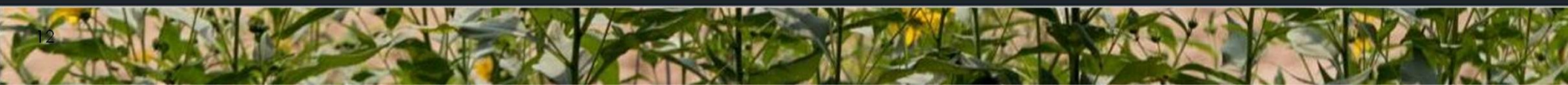

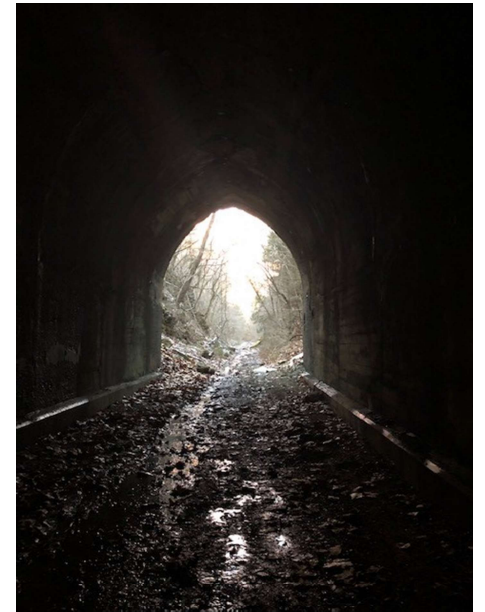


2022 Attendance Numbers
